DECEMBER GOALS MEETING

Ten people from Avonwood met on Friday, December 1st to discuss the format of future discussions, and our visions for the group as a whole. Five points were addressed: who makes Avonwood what it is, how decisions are made, what our communication looks like, meeting locations, and event attendance.

1. Who is Avonwood

Those present at the discussions determined that anyone within our geographical boundaries (once determined) is considered a member of the Village of Avonwood. Furthermore, anyone wishing to be counted among the Village of Avonwood is welcome to do so. Further discussions of participation (especially in terms of folks new to the SCA) were relocated to the following discussions.

2. How decisions are made

All decisions pertaining to the group at large will be introduced at a monthly meeting, and voted upon at the next meeting, by those physically present. Decisions to be voted on will be publically announced prior to the vote, and any unable to attend the meeting may participate by:

- a) Designating someone present to vote on their behalf, and alerting the Seneschal of this.
- b) Attending electronically via skype, gmail, messenger or other mutual platform OR via phone call
- c) Sending their vote in writing to the Seneschal or Seneschal-elected delegate prior to the meeting.

Two methods of determining when a non-officer can vote were proposed:

- a) Vouching-for by a voting member
- b) Point system

Further elaboration on these proposals will be posted and discussed at the December Planning meeting prior to voting.

3. What our communication looks like:

In two words, be nice! All members of the Village of Avonwood, no matter their experience, have a right to have their thoughts heard in a respectful environment. At meetings, a Talking Stick/Object will be utilized to ensure fair turn-taking at all times.

The rules to be exercised during the use of the Talking Stick/Object will be posted at all meetings and are as follows:

- a) Whoever has the Talking Stick has the floor. No one else may speak.
- b) The current holder of the Talking Stick will designate who can speak next by giving them the Talking Stick.
- c) Anyone may request the Talking Stick by raising a hand.
- d) Anyone not holding the Talking Stick must listen respectfully
- e) We will keep our discussions impersonal. Conversations of a personal nature are to be addressed before or after meetings in a civil manner.

4. Meeting locations:

All present determined moving or cycling the location of the monthly meetings was agreeable. Anyone wishing to add a location to the cycle should investigate potential locations an (must be able to hold at

least 10 people, for two hours) and report their findings/contact information to the Seneschal for reservation.
